### 2017 GUIDELINES

OFFERED JOINTLY BY THE  
BRAZOS ASSOCIATION FOR CLASSICAL HORSEMANSHIP (BACH)  
AND TOPSIDER FARM

**Note:** Four shows are scheduled. In case of inclement weather or insufficient entries we reserve the right to cancel or reschedule shows and to make adjustments in the minimum number of shows or tests required for eligibility.

#### **Award Levels and Categories:**

- USDF Introductory Level Junior/Young Rider and Adult Amateur
- USEF Training Level through Second Level Jr/YR, Ad Am, and Open
- USEF Third Level and Above Open (ie Jr/YR, Ad Am and Open riders combined)

#### **Eligibility for Awards:**

1. No memberships, extra fees, applications or sign-ups are required. BACH members pay reduced class fees.
2. A Rider may compete with more than one Horse; eligibility requirements for each Pair must be met separately.
3. A Horse/Rider Pair **must**  
Enter and receive scores in a minimum of **two** of the four Series shows;  
Earn scores in a minimum of **four tests** for Intro thru Second Level, **two tests** for Third Level and above;
4. A horse/rider pair may compete at and be eligible for awards in two consecutive levels with a minimum of four scores per level. Scores are averaged for each level separately and may not be combined.
5. A pair's **top four scores** at an Award Level/Category will be used for averaging.
6. A **Champion Pair** at a Level become **ineligible** for an Award at that Level in the future.

#### **Awards:**

Champions and Reserve Champions

1. Will be designated for the eligible Pair with the highest and second highest average score in each Level/Category.
2. Will be announced in the BACH newsletter and emailed to award recipients.
3. Will receive a Prize of a gift certificate, ribbon, and/or Award item with Champion or Reserve designation.
